Open to ambitious businesses that are currently experiencing or have the potential for high growth, Scale to Thrive offers an exclusive package of support for like-minded business leaders interested in connecting with others, exploring new markets and developing their business strategy.

Onboarding

Meet the Scale to Thrive community and kick off your journey with your dedicated Business Scale-up Advisor and Mentor for the duration of the programme.

Group work

You will become part of a cohort, of business leaders that will benefit from Action learning, a powerful technique that enable you to explore and reflect on opportunities and challenges, through typically 4 2-3 hour professionally facilitated session as a group.

In addition, group work will be strengthened through access to a series of Masterclasses on key topics to choose from.

Community network

Our events will help you create, connections, gain insights and find new, opportunities for collaboration through our wider network of partners and successful, scale-up leaders.

- You will benefit from a personalised industry benchmark report and an accompanying Scale-up Strategy and Action plan.

How to get involved -**Timeline**

Stage 1: Apply online for the Scale to Thrive programme at the Boost website and tell us about your scale-up vision and why now is the right time for your business to join this programme.

Stage 2: Our panel will shortlist and agree the companies with the best fit for the programme, with those selected informed shortly after. If you are not selected, we can make warm introductions to other services that might be better suited to where you are in your growth journey currently. Future competitive calls will also be open to previous applicants when they are ready.

Stage 3: Our successful business leaders are allocated a Business Scale-up Advisor who will register you on the programme and help shape you plans and support access to the programme activities and appropriate services from wider providers both publicly funded and private sector specialists.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for Scale to Thrive your business must:

- Have a minimum annual turnover of £1m and/or 10 FTE staff
- Have demonstrate a history of annual expansion over the last 3 years
- Or are already scaling 20% year on year
- Has ambitious leadership with the drive to scaleup activities and push ahead on innovation, investment, and internationalisation
- Is forecasting to grow turnover and/ or employees 20% year on year for the next 3 year
- Or be a start-up business showing rapid growth in the first year with future projections to scale over the next 3 years.
- Are based in and trading from one of the 10 Local Partner District postcode areas; Blackburn with Darwen, Burnley, Chorley, Fylde, Hyndburn, Pendle, Preston, South Ribble, West Lancashire and Wyre.
- Meet the above criteria and can be small, medium-sized or large business. This also includes social enterprises where these engage in economic activity. The business can be from any sector or industry.
